(2) Chapter 2, p. 38., third paragraph: Bulgaria used a random quota sample for CAWI and a proportional stratified sampling procedure for CATI. That was changed to: *Bulgaria used a random quota sample for CAWI and a proportional stratified sampling procedure for CAPI.*

(3) Chapter 2, p.53, fourth paragraph: There were also mixed types, namely CAWI + CATI (by BG, CZ, IL, and IT) and CAPI + CAWI (by SI). The sentence was corrected to: *There were also mixed types, namely CAWI + CATI (by CZ, IL, and IT) and CAPI + CAWI (by BG and SI).*

(4) Chapter 2, p. 39. Table 2.10, column BG first line: CATI was changed to: *CAPI.*

(5) Chapter 4, p. 73, line 5 from the bottom: » Inadequate: “very easy” < 8.334, “very difficult” AND “difficult” ≥ 50. That was changed to: » *Inadequate: “very easy” < 8.334 AND “very difficult” + “difficult” ≥ 50*
